

The Willard Eldred Legacy Society a.k.a. Bill's Society

Bequests are generally used to improve the physical building and/or financial circumstances of a church beyond what annual pledges can do. Because it is usually not possible to predict the needs or priorities of a church at the time of one's death (since we don't know when we will die), usually the best thing is to make your request undesignated. This gives the Vestry the greatest flexibility in applying your gift in accordance with the needs and priorities of the church at the time of your death.

Here are a couple of possible current uses for your bequest:

- Renovation of the upper floor into classroom space.
- Reduce our mortgage debt.

Other uses could include:

- Add to our investments which would provide interest to fund the operating expenses.
- A plan for replacement of equipment (i.e., furnaces).
- Renovations to the kitchen and fellowship areas.
